

PAUL G. CHENKOVICH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Paul G. Chenkovich Memorial Scholarship provides educational opportunities to children of current and former members of the Livermore-Pleasanton Fire Department. Captain Chenkovich was a dedicated firefighter for over 23 years who died in 2013 from job-related cancer. His legacy lives in every life he touched and in his selfless service to others. In his memory, the scholarship will assist others to achieve their goals in becoming a firefighter or EMT.

The scholarship fund was created by family and fellow firefighters to continue Captain Chenkovich's commitment and dedication to helping others through education. Candidates seeking a Paul G. Chenkovich Memorial Scholarship must complete an application and forward it to the Livermore-Pleasanton Firefighter Foundation by June 1st.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD AMOUNT AND DISTRIBUTION

- Each scholarship award amount is \$1,000
- A scholarship recipient is not eligible to re-apply for PGC Scholarship, if they have already received one.
- Scholarship awards will be announced in the month of July.
- Awards will be made directly to the applicants for the upcoming academic year upon verification of enrollment in either a certificate or degree program in Fire Science or EMT School.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Candidate's must complete a Paul G. Chenkovich Memorial Scholarship Application and send it to the Livermore-Pleasanton Firefighters Foundation by June 1st.

- Applicants must be a LPFD Explorer or a child of a current or former LPFD Firefighter or EMT.
- Available to high school seniors / graduates and college students enrolled in Fire Science or EMT programs.
- Must have a 3.0 GPA during senior year of high school / current college transcript.

SELECTION CRITERIA

- Applicants will be assessed and selected based on the following criteria:
- All information provided in the application
- Transcripts of grades and supporting documents for college/EMT school
- A thoughtful and compelling essay
